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

When a Veteran Enrolls in Hospice Care...

The veteran's specific needs related to military service are identified, so that optimal end of life care can be provided.

By providing care specifically tailored to veterans and their families and meeting the veteran's goals for care in their preferred setting, Hospice is better able to accompany them toward a more peaceful end of life.

Veteran Specific Services Include:

- Care coordination with VA clinics and resources
- Care provided by Hospice staff and volunteers who have each received education about veteran needs
- Veteran to Veteran volunteer patient care and companionship is available upon request.
- Family support specific to veteran's needs
- Grief support specific for a veteran's family

Each veteran on Hospice care is presented with a table top American flag and a beautiful, patriotic lap quilt, handmade and donated by local quilters.
